CONTEST

For participation in sports photography exhibition

Contest rules:

- Applications can be submitted by amateur and professional photographers without any restrictions.
- Photographs must be taken in 2019 and 2020 (due to the limited possibilities of taking photographs in 2020 caused by the coronavirus pandemic, works taken in 2019 are exceptionally accepted, provided they have not already been submitted to this competition).
- Author can submit unlimited number of photographs, but up to three works (either photographs or collections) of the same sport except in athletics (up to three photographs per discipline). Collection is made out of three photographs and is accepted as one work. When applying, collection must be clearly indicated and the order of each photograph of the collection must be specifically marked. Author may create a collection by himself in one of available programs for photography editing.
- Author can submit up to three (3) photographs addressing fair play in sport – photographs that transfer the idea of fair play and ethics in sport.
- The author can submit up to (3) photographs in the category "Sports in Crisis" - photographs that in any way convey the atmosphere and state of sport during a coronavirus pandemic.
- Application and delivery of photographs must be made via [online form](https://www.sport-pgz.hr) available at official web page of Zajednica sportova Primorsko-goranske županije (www.sport-pgz.hr)
- Photographs are sent in digital form only, in .jpg/.jpeg/ format. Single size of each photography/document must not exceed 5 MB or 300 dpi of resolution.
- Photographs can be in color/B/, monochromatic/M/ and black-white /CB/
- Processing the photography is allowed in a way that doesn't impair or change the basic meaning of recorded material.
- Deadline for delivery of photographs is **November 3, 2020**.

Judgement committee (jury):

By deadline expiry all submitted photographs will be examined by Judgement committee, members of which are representatives of profession and organizers.

Judgement committee will choose up to 50 best photographs and prepare them for the exhibition. Of those photographs that will be shown at the exhibition, best ones will be elected and awarded with first, second or third prize and special acknowledgement.

Catalogue of exhibition:

Organizer will publish catalogue in digital form and deliver it to each contest participant on e-mail address given in application.

Copyright:

- Photographs may be used in promotional purposes such as in the exhibition catalogue, poster, sports yearbook and other publications issued by organizers and Internet posts on organizers' Internet pages. All mentioned forms of posts are of non-commercial value with the only purpose of promoting the exhibition, author and sports in general ,
- Some of elected photographs will be printed on exhibition's promotional material, such as invitations for exhibition's opening and other events, poster or information for media. All of mentioned forms of advertisements are of non-commercial value and their only purpose is exhibition, sport and authors' promotion,
- Organizers maintain the right to use submitted photographs in purpose of sport popularization, implementation of Olympic principles and activities related to promotion of culture and art in context of sport.
- Moral copyright, in a sense of rightful author's signing in any form of publication, will be respected ,
- Contest participant applies solely his/her own photographs and takes responsibilities for authenticity and content of submitted photographs,
- By applying to the contest, participants agree to all terms of contest.

Results announcement:

Results of the contest will be published on web site of Zajednica sportova Primorsko-goranske županije. Authors will be noted via e-mail by the end of November 2020.

Personal data protection:

- By filling application form and uploading photographs, the author gives his/her consent to the Contest organizer for gathering, processing and storage of personal data due to the organization of Sports photography contest 2020.
- Gathered data will be used for photographs identification and informing participants about Contest results and notices related to the Exhibition opening and authors' prizes
- The data won't be forwarded to the third party

Exhibition of best photographs:

- After contest is conducted, organizers will present best photographs at the exhibition which will be held **at the beginning of December 2020 in Rijeka, Croatia.**
- Place and the exact time of exhibition will be defined afterwards. Except in Rijeka, exhibition may be held in other places in Croatia or in associates' countries.
